The Jewels on the High Priest's Breastplate

71 pages : A5 booklet format

The Gemstones of the Twelve Tribes. These gemstones were set in the High Priest's Breastplate, but there has been considerable debate over the exact positioning of them. The Bible gives us the order of the stones, according to the marching order of the Tribes (see *Exodus 28:21*). However some scholars have debated whether the sequence of stones was horizontal or vertical. It would seem that since the names engraved on the gems were meant to be read, then the order of stones would be as Hebrew is written: from right to left in the horizontal manner. There is also the problem of translation. Some of the names given to the stones found in the King James Version have been translated differently in modern versions. There seems to have been different names given to the different stones throughout the centuries, and this has caused extra controversy. Despite this, I have chosen to follow the King James Version for this study.

Passover: celebrating Yeshua in the first feast

PESACH or Passover is the first and foundational Feast of the Lord. The other six feasts build upon this one. There has only ever been **one Passover**, and that was when the Lord God passed through the land of Egypt in judgment. Since then all Passover celebrations have been *memorials* to that very first occasion (Exo. 12: 14 and 13: 3) Likewise there was only one crucifixion and death of Yeshua. All our celebrations of the Lord's Supper are reminders of that once for all great event - "Do this in *remembrance* of Me". So as we celebrate and remember the Israelite's deliverance from Egypt we also rejoice in our deliverance from sin through Yeshua. The celebration of Passover has been going on for over 3,500 years probably making it the longest *continuous* feast of its type in the world!

The Three Prophetic Feasts

God has said that He will meet with man three times. He has given us symbols of these "meetings" in the Three Feasts He ordained Israel to keep. In fact he commanded them not to appear before Him "empty handed". They were not simply to witness the Feasts, nor just to participate in them. They had to bring something costly! How sad that many come to the fulfilment of these feasts today in their own Christian experience, thinking they do not have to "pay the price". Certainly all of God's works toward us are of Grace; they are free, unmerited, and even undeserved; but nevertheless given by Him as a great act of divine generosity. This is GRACE! How dare we then think we can waltz into His Presence and simply partake of these wonderful Feasts He lays before us. It will require the laying down of our own soul life, our

ambitions, our desires; our own satisfactions must be crucified. This is what we bring in our hands when we come to His feasts. As we study them it is paramount that we learn of them in order to become them! The Feasts were for ancient Israel to *keep*; they are for the Church to *“become”*! As we look at these Feasts we will see that they have been perfectly ordered in their timing, their symbolism and their sequence, to give us the clearest possible understanding of what God intends for us to experience.

[Incubus and Succubus](#)

59 pages : A5 booklet format

The first thing I want to say is that visitations from these demon powers are very real! If you've been sexually molested or confronted by some invisible power while you slept, I want you to know that you're not alone. Although not commonly talked about, these frightening occurrences are quite real. But there is a way out! Many people keep from telling others about their experiences out of embarrassment, shame or ridicule. It doesn't help when Christian Ministers and Pastors discount the possibility of sexual encounters with demons and call it fantasy. Yet the reality is there. In the past 28 years I have ministered to a number of people, usually females, who have tentatively broached the subject with me. Many Christian leaders have been surprised at just how many believers have been afflicted by this. It simply cannot be put down to a psychological repression of unfilled sexual desires.

Much of modern psychology uses this excuse, but the reality is far from this. I'm not discounted the possibility that *some* night-time solo sexual experiences are the result of suppressed desires, but too many people who've actually experienced the molestation know different. Although the topic is by nature based on the subjectivity of the victim's own experience, this shouldn't make us treat it as a delusion of an irrational or psychotic personality. Many of the victims are mature, well balanced and responsible people - they are "normal" yet experience periodic visits from "night demons".

[Biblical Typology](#)

116 pages : A5 booklet format

In the Bible Paul gives us an important principle to work from, namely, that there is *“first the natural and then the spiritual”* (1 Cor 15: 46). This principle is a well-known one in both the Teaching and Prophetic circles, as it forms a good New Testament basis for understanding the symbolic language of Scripture. It's as if the Lord has given us created things to show forth a spiritual truth. This can only be understood and appreciated when we begin to dig out the treasures of the Word.

The so-called language of Creation becomes to us the language of Spiritual Insight. We need to be cautious in the use of Biblical texts, and by the Holy Spirit, seek His revelation knowledge on what a particular verse might mean. There is a need to clarify what is a symbol and what is a

Biblical type. Since the first edition of this booklet in 1997 I have added many other insights that has resulted in a 50% increase in the size of this publication.

Included are the meanings of the Hebrew alphabet, months of the year and meaning of the 12 sons of Jacob and 12 Tribes of Israel. I have found that many people are still hungering for understanding in these areas. If you are one, then I pray and hope that you will continue to seek the wisdom of the Holy Spirit in your reading and application of these “types and shadows”.

The following chart gives an example of certain types and their meanings.

ALABASTER	Grace; preciousness; value.
BRASS	Judgment against sin; endurance and the strength that goes with it; disobedience.
BRICK	Man-made religiosity; false religion.
BRIMSTONE	Judgment from God.
BRONZE	Needing refinement (note that Bronze is a combination of metals and therefore not pure).
CLAY	Frailty of human flesh; the weakness of character.

Biblical Numbers

68 pages : A5 booklet format

In the Book of Daniel chapter 8 verses 13 and 14 there is a reference to an anonymous being called “*that certain one*”. In Hebrew the word is “**Palmoni**” which has been translated as “*the Numberer of Secrets*” or “*the wonderful Numberer*”. It is possible that this is an angel whose ministry deals with numbers! We also can see that God is concerned about numbering. These texts support this view:

Job 14:16 “*For now You **number** my steps, But do not watch over my sin*”.

Psa 90:12 “*So teach us to **number** our days, That we may gain a heart of wisdom*”.

Psa 147:4 “*He counts the **number** of the stars; He calls them all by name*”.

The use of numbers to seek out deeper truths in the Word of God is scorned and rejected by some, yet it is obvious that numbers do take on a spiritual meaning and significance when dealt with according to some guidelines that do not destroy the witness and harmony of the Scriptures. The following shows some Biblical meanings to numbers found in the Word of God.

The Number 4 : The Prime meaning; UNIVERSAL

Other meanings; CREATIVE WORK; CREATION; EQUALITY.

Some examples

- Traditionally there were **four** cups of wine at the Passover
- There are **four** judgments linked to the **four** horns of the empires (Rev 6:1-8 & Zech 1:20-21)
- There is a **four** fold mention of the cup in the chief butler's dream (Gen 40:9-15)
- There are the **four** cups of God's vengeance on the nations (Jer 25:15 & 51:7)

Themes and Principles of Scripture

60 pages : A5 booklet format

For the past 11 years I have been searching the Word of God for patterns and principles that underlay its overall meaning. In doing so I have noticed that generally speaking, we find **Principles** contained in the Old Testament, and **Doctrines** in the New. It is also true I think that when we cannot find any pattern established in the writings of the New Testament it is valid to search for them within the Old Testament. As I did this over the last few years, I began to write down these principles and themes that were woven into the stories, lives and moves of God with His people. This booklet and its accompanying manual is the result of that study. I hope it will encourage you to seek after the treasures in the Word of God, and that the compilation of some of these principles and themes may enlighten you in your study, both of the Word, and of people and their motives. Some examples:

RELIGION / WITCHCRAFT

Religion fosters witchcraft and vice versa. Witchcraft is 'stolen power' and breeds in the darkness. Religion keeps people 'in the dark' concerning spiritual truths.

TEXTS Prov 9, vs 17-18

ADULTERY / LITERAL & SPIRITUAL

For a Christian to commit literal adultery increases the likelihood of them falling into spiritual adultery, ie. wrong doctrine. Likewise the teaching of false doctrine will inevitably lead to the person committing actual adultery. Actual physical adultery leads to lying (in the natural, to the other spouse) and deceit; so also spiritual adultery leads to the deceit of false doctrine and error (Jer 9, vs 2b-3a).

TEXTS Compare in Scripture the link between False words and Seduction : Prov 2, vs 16 / Prov 5, vs 3, 12-14,23 / Prov 6, vs 24 / Prov 6, vs 32 / Jer 29, vs 23

BLESSING BY THE RIGHTEOUS

A community, city, people, fellowship are exalted when the upright / righteous begin to bless. Alternately a fellowship, city, etc can be pulled down by the use of our words (eg. gossip). A righteous man is a mainstay for his community.

TEXTS 2 Chron 22, vs 3 / 24, vs 15-18 / Prov 11, vs 11 / Prov 12, vs 18

The Three Fold truths

27 pages : A5 booklet format

Throughout Scripture there is an on-going revelation of Truth showing how God has revealed His character and purpose in a **THREE-FOLD SEQUENCE**. This initially begins with God's revelation of Himself as a Triune Personality, being the orthodox Christian doctrine of THE TRINITY, that is, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Man is made in this image, having Spirit, Soul and Body. From this revelatory truth comes many other Three Fold Truths, such as the three Courts of the Tabernacle, i.e., **Outer Court, Holy Place, Most Holy Place**. Each of these corresponds to a particular truth or set of truths that helps unfold the wonders of God's design in both the natural and spiritual realms.

The booklet is meant to highlight some of the known, and lesser known, revelations that are based on this Three Fold Sequence. Each one by itself could yield a marvellous insight into how God intends His people to move from one truth into deeper truth. Although they are interesting in themselves, these truths are not meant solely for the gaining of knowledge, but are intended to be **EXPERIENCED!** For example, you could have gained insight from the progression of the three Feasts of Passover, Pentecost and then Tabernacles; but unless they become an actual EXPERIENCE that you enter into personally, you have gained little but knowledge.

Great Southland of the Holy Spirit

18 pages : A5 booklet format

This short publication is Issachar research paper number 1. It was done as part of the Spiritual Mapping programme of the International Spiritual Warfare Conference held at Seoul, in October 1993, called by Dr. Peter Wagner. I was part of the Australia/Pacific delegation invited to attend, to present material pertinent to our region regarding Spiritual Warfare and Spiritual Mapping techniques. Our regional coordinator was Noel Bell, of (then) Intercessors For Australia.

Three hundred ministries were invited from around the world to share and encourage each other to adequately prepare for the coming Harvest into the Kingdom. Already at that time significant revivals were underway in Latin America and elsewhere, often spawned by Spiritual Mapping techniques backed up by prayer, intercession and evangelism. Peter Wagner dubbed these invited ministries "Gideon's 300 Army". It was a significant milestone in the networking of many different ministries that would eventually take many forms some of which are known today as The International Prayer Network, AD2000, Global Prayer house, Reconciliation Marches, Prayer Walking, Taking our Cities for God, etc. My research project was to present material on Spiritual Mapping regarding Australia in particular, with some reference to other insights from around the world.

During my preparation I came across articles relating to the discovery of the South Pacific by the Portuguese, especially the voyages of Fernando De Quiros, and his claims on the region in the name of the King of Spain and Roman Catholicism. It was during one of these expeditions that the name "*Great Southland of the Holy Spirit*" was used. As will be seen in this booklet, that term does **not** refer to the Australian Continent at all, but to the entire region of the southern Pacific Ocean. Christians today need integrity in making claims about the supposed "words" spoken over this nation. This research project was an attempt to help address this issue.

The Pope's Line

17 pages : A5 booklet format

This study is Issachar research paper number 2. The concept of Spiritual Mapping, which has played a part in some of the Latin American revivals of recent decades, is testament to the validity of its use in modern evangelism. In writing this paper I have used some of the principles used by “mappers” to highlight a little known historical event that I believe has spiritual implications for Australia, in particular the state of Western Australia. In 1494 Pope Alexander VI declared the then known world should be divided in two to satisfy continuing brawling between Spanish and Portuguese explorers. The resulting line of demarcation was called “*the Pope’s Line*”. This study will look at how this came about, what spiritual implications it has, and the resulting effects on Australia. It would be worthwhile reading my companion study to this, called “***The Great Southland of the Holy Spirit***”.

Scripture urges us to be alert to the wiles of our adversary, Satan. It is clear from the Word of God that not only do individuals worship false gods, but that towns, cities and nations themselves have often been dedicated to unholy spiritual powers and thereby influenced by them. Whenever we come across such bondage in the nations we are to bring in the light of the Gospel. One way this can be done is to engage in spiritual warfare using information we have regarding that country’s history and heritage. On three occasions Australia has been give given over to the “protection” of Mary as the Queen of Heaven. This must have some detrimental spiritual effect upon our nation’s psyche. If that be true, then so too would the Pope’s Line. In this booklet you will see how this might be so, with some suggestions what to do about it. I believe that Western Australia in particular has been affected detrimentally by the drawing of the Pope’s Line. For that longitudinal line also happens to be the eastern boundary of the entire state!

Building the House of the Lord studies

31 pages : A5 booklet format

The Lord is building His house in the hearts and spirits of His people. This has always been His intention, and in these days we see a quickening of the Spirit of God to inspire us to accelerate this process. This booklet is a compilation of the four study papers used as foundational teachings in the *City of Palms Fellowship*, based in Carnarvon, Western Australia, of which I am a joint elder.

The four chapter headings are:

- What is the House?
- The House is Holy
- The House is Worthy
- The House is Great

This is our goal, this is our unalterable destiny - this is our prize: I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this same mind. (Philp. 3: 14-15). We have felt it important to set out some of the insights and truths pertaining to this hour in the world wide Ecclesia regarding our walk before the Lord. May these eternal truths infect us with a new desire to follow closely after Jesus in all we do !

New Wine teaching

53 pages : A5 booklet format

These ten chapters were originally produced as single-sheet topics for individual or group study. Increasingly it became obvious that they needed to be bound together as one volume so that “flow study” could be achieved. “Flow study” means that the topics can be studied either individually or better still, in sequence, thus forming a “flow” of truth. For this reason the subjects have been grouped together as much as possible in similarity. Most of the topics are “present hour” truths that call us to deeper understanding and more radical commitment in applying them. It is intended that they will convict us to aim for maturity of spirit and soul. Take time to seriously consider the truths here and allow the Spirit of Truth to lead us into all truth!

Topics include:

- Circumcision of the heart
- Inner realm change
- Living from the spirit
- Abiding and resting in Christ
- Are we doing this?
- The voice of God
- Leadership and ministry
- The prophetic in leadership
- Prophetic call and commission
- Prophetic principles

Is the god of Islam the same as the God of the Bible?

86 pages : A5 booklet format

In asking the fundamental question “Is the god of Islam the same as the God of the Bible?” we find the answer to that in relation to how the Koran rates other Biblical beliefs. When we understand how these other beliefs are treated in the Koran it’s obvious that Allah the god of Islam is definitely **not** the same as the revealed God of the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures. So we’ll pose a number of questions and let the Koran speak for itself in the matter. The topics most in question for us as disciples of Jesus are:

Who is Allah?

What does the Koran teach, and Islam accept about -

- Jesus as the Son of God,
- The doctrine of the Trinity,
- The views of other religions,
- Jihad against other religions?

This study looks at quotes taken directly from the Koran and checks them against Scripture giving us a real insight to just what Islam believes and does not believe in relation to the Bible.

Principles of Revival

12 pages : A5 booklet format

This is a short but highly encouraging booklet on Revival principles. Revival is simply an extraordinary move of the Holy Spirit resulting in extra-ordinary results. It is an invasion from Heaven, a grand demonstration of God's power over the wills of men. It's as if a near dead corpse had a sudden inrush of Spirit-breathe. Someone even said revival is like "God's finger pointing at me!" But perhaps the greatest definition is by Charles Finney: "Revival is nothing else than a new beginning of obedience to God." Throughout recent Church history certain terms have been used to express such a great move. Some of the more common ones are:

A Spiritual Awakening
Time of Refreshing
Rending the Heavens
An Outpouring of the Spirit
A Divine Visitation.

Although we cannot order an Awakening or manufacture a Revival, there are certain conditions that give birth to a revival, and there are certain common themes that mark one. We cannot have an awakening on our own terms. It's only when we fulfil the required conditions that heaven pours forth a divine manifestation of Love, Mercy and Restoration. The responsibility to enter into prayer is ours, although of course it is He who puts the desire within us initially. He is always the architect of our needs. Wonderful Lord! Think on the following:

- We need to have an awareness of our need. Before revival breaks forth there needs to be a realisation of our spiritual poverty and lukewarmness. Unless we can see the true state of the Church, and ourselves, we will never even begin to consider praying for revival.
- Having a burden. Revival is never born apart from travail in prayer; a spiritual desperation and yearning from deep within. The old saying still holds true: The prayer that doesn't move your heart is unlikely to move God's either!
- Prevailing prayer. History clearly shows the one outstanding requirement for revival is a return to intercessory and prevailing prayer. Anything that substitutes for increased prayer will keep us away from experiencing revival. The prayer meeting is always the first target of Satan and the first group in the Church to be depleted. Every true God-born revival has begun when the saints get on their knees. There never has been, nor will there ever be, such a thing as a prayerless revival.

The Mystery Revealed

78 pages : A5 booklet format

Only by revelation do truths come to us. Understanding this principle will save us much heartache when we don't see people respond to teaching the way we think they should. Revelation-truth is actually a form of light. "Revelation" is the supernatural imparting of truth that sheds light on something that was previously either partially obscured, or totally hidden from view. At the end of his life Paul the Apostle received revelation of a Great Mystery that surpassed all he had received up to that point. This in-depth study on the Epistle to the Ephesians gives a verse-by-verse commentary about correctly discerning what the Word is revealing. Has an appendix of notes dealing with such topics as "The Overthrow", "Eternity", "The Four Dimensions of the Mystery" and "The Mystery" itself. Challenging, but worthwhile.

Tree of Life studies

52 pages : A5 booklet format

This series of 6 studies is intended, like the New Wine teaching booklet, to encourage the believer to move from “milk’ and feast on the “meat” of the Word.

Chapters include:

- Being a True Disciple
- Principles of a Model Pastor
- Revelation parallels Genesis
- The Power of our words
- The Tabernacle pattern
- Protocols for the Sons of God

Each study is meat by itself. But when this booklet is studied in-depth it will yield much maturity – if we are willing to “do” rather than simply “learn”. The studies are well adapted to group study. They are deliberately presented in a study format, with unnecessary detail omitted. More than the bare bones are presented however, but you will still find the studies require you to think and ponder deeply on these Bible truths.

Study Manuals (7 in total)

Spiritual Mapping

66 pages : A4 format

For some this topic is controversial. However this resource manual is an attempt to show that Mapping is one of the many tools suitable for evangelism. The manual has topics that include:

- What is Spiritual mapping?
- Who should be on the Team?
- What to look for in Mapping
- Interpreting the information
- Cautions, Counsel and Controversies
- Example of a Prayer Walking Diary

The manual (the first of its type in Australia) has 37 maps from around the world that show how Spiritual Mapping can be used for evangelism. Plenty of room for note taking.

The Last Days

75 pages : A4 format

This study focuses on principles concerning the End Times and Last Days and avoids dealing with date setting. It's not my intention to propose some sort of scenario that will lock us into accepting a view on the Last Days that will not allow ongoing revelation from the Holy Spirit. Some of the insights shared here will challenge many Christians because they do not fit the popular concept of either the Tribulation or the Rapture. It's been said that the majority of the Messianic texts about Jesus weren't fulfilled until the last 24 hours of his earthly life. If that's so, then perhaps it'll be the same about the End of the Age. Not until we're either entering in or at the Last Days themselves will we understand some of the more difficult End Time texts. Let's be open to the ongoing revelation of the Holy Spirit our Teacher. If our traditions or dearly loved doctrines get knocked to and fro as a result, then so be it. It's time to stand for truth. Sometimes we're not as open to God as we think we are!

Often it's a religious spirit that will rise up in anger and condemnation when our pet theories are challenged. Quite rightly it's been said, "*God offends our mind to reveal our heart.*" Think of some occasion when someone has challenged one of your dearly held theories. Inside of us a righteous indignation will rise up and display itself. How often we bite back without thinking the issue through, let alone judging and discerning it correctly according to the Word of God. I have found this in my own life a number of times, but because I've been challenged by others to commit myself to Truth I've learnt the hard way by having to go away and really think things through. Having done this and progressively learnt how to correctly discern the Word of God, I've come to a place where Truth means more to me than reputation.

Worship from the beginning

It's been said that the greatest act of worship ever known was done entirely without music! It was the willing death of Jesus Christ upon the Cross! Makes you think what worship is really about. This extensive study manual was specially written for the School of Worship seminars conducted at the YWAM base in Perth, Western Australia. This manual is NOT a dictionary containing “dream meanings” but it does set out to show the Biblical evidence for dreams, visions and even trances.

It also looks at the physiological nature of how the dream state affects the body. There are many charts in this manual to assist in understanding this important subject.
